Lorenzo Meyer is widely recognized as the foremost historian and political analyst in Mexico. Dr. Meyer is a professor at the most prestigious academic institution in Mexico, El Colegio de México. Dr. Meyer is also an editorialist at the leading national newspaper Reforma. Since the late 70's Dr. Meyer has published numerous books and academic articles on Mexican history, politics, culture, among other subjects. He received a PhD in International Relations from El Colegio de México and did post-doctoral research in the Department of Political Science at the University of Chicago. He is a member of Mexico's National System of Researchers and has been a visiting professor in numerous universities such as: University of California, San Diego, Columbia University, University of Chicago, and Stanford University.
